WINEMAKING

Varietal composition: Pinot Noir

The grapes are hand-harvested at our own estate in Mainque, Upper Rio Negro Valley, and then they go through a cold maceration. Fermentation takes place in small concrete tanks in a slow, cool temperature-controlled process, with 30% of the cluster. We use both indigenous and selected yeasts. Malolactic fermentation also takes place in tanks. Some wine has been oak-aged for 12 months.

Attractive pale ruby color. With lovely aromas of red fruit such as cranberry and straw-berry, along with some hints of roses and earthy minerals. Round tannins and an enhanced minerality, with a beautiful structure and finish.
