SPARKLING WINES from Chile

Apaltagua Winery is owned by the Tutunjian family and they specialize in appellation-based wines. Their estate vineyards are located mainly in the prestigious Apalta region of the Colchagua Valley, but their properties reach north to San Antonio Valley and south to Maule Valley where agricultural production includes pomegranate orchards. Winemaker Pablo Barros has infused Apaltagua's sparkling wine production with new excitement and originality by incorporating this tangy fruit into their Granate Demi-Sec.



APALTAGUA GRANATE DEMI-SEC

60% Chardonnay, 40% Pomegranate juice

The Granate Demi-Sec is a refreshing cocktail of Chardonnay and Pomegranate juice, a new concept in sparkling wine. The fruit (including the pomegranate) comes from Apaltagua's Huaquen property in the Maule Valley coastal range where the cool Mediterranean style climate is ideal for both Chardonnay and pomegranate production.

The wine is aromatic with obvious hints of pomegranate and notes of red fruits like strawberries and raspberries. It is juicy and vibrant with a medium body and a pleasant effervescence and roundness that enhances the fresh fruit character.



APALTAGUA COSTERO

60% Chardonnay, 40% Sauvignon Blanc

Apaltagua's San Antonio Valley property produces the Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay for Costero. The fruit is harvested by hand from vines that enjoy a cool climate in sandy soils that contain clay and granite with calcareous deposits.

Costero sparkling wine (methode champenoise) is a serious dry sparkling wine. It is pale gold in color, with fine bubbles. On the nose it is clean with marked notes of white fruits, such as green and yellow apples. Notes of crusty bread and hazelnuts mix with a delicate hint of buttery aromas. It is creamy on the palate with subtle flavors of citrus, and finishes fresh, clean and long.



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
