
## The Domus Aurea Family of Wines





# DOMUS AUREA UPPER MAIPO VALLEY




Domus Aurea is recognized as one of the great wines of Chile. On the gravelly slopes of their 75-year old vineyard, owners Ricardo and Isabel Peña and winemaker Jean-Pascal Lacaze produce their award-winning wine. Committed to extremely low yields, their vineyards are divided into five blocks that follow the depth and stoniness of the soil, which are further divided into upper, middle and lower rows. The harvest is not determined by block or row, but vine-by-vine. The winery utilizes open-top fermentation and personalized oak aging cycles, selecting the best plots with the best fruit for extended barrel aging.

The wine is deep intense garnet in the glass with a nose of black currants and blackberries. An attractive eucalyptus note mixed with fresh cigar, cedar and spicy vanilla followed by a layer of blueberries, mineral and spice finishing with smooth, refined tannins. Domus Aurea vintages routinely score 90+ each and every vintage.

# PEÑALOLEN MAIPO VALLEY

The Peñalolen Cabernet Sauvignon vineyard produces excellent low-yield fruit and was established next to the Domus Aurea vineyard 35 years ago. The operation is managed by the well respected and talented winemaker, Jean-Pascal Lacaze, with his deft hand and expertise in producing memorable Bordeaux influenced wines. Peñalolen truly is a family-owned, boutique property committed to making wines of distinction.

The Cabernet Sauvignon is a complex and velvety wine with abundant fruit of wild berries and cassis, and a refined whisper of eucalyptus and tremendous length.

## ANKA A

MAIPO VALLEY

Anka is a vibrant, organic red blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Carménère and Syrah. It is a deep ruby color in the glass with balsmaic aromas and dried herb on the nose. Floral hints of sweet spice accompanied by a roundness in the mouth are lush, but not heavy, and the texture is velvety with fine tannins. Jean-Pascal Lacaze organically farms the grapes at his Maipo Valley vineyard, Pargua. Using only hand selected fruit, he ages the wine in individually selected barrels and then manually blends the wine barrel by barrel.
