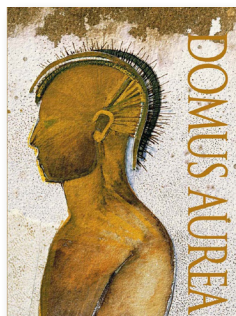


UPPER MAIPO VALLEY

The DOMUS AUREA Family of Wines

Domus Aurea is a family-owned winery producing traditional wines made memorable by preserving the harmony that exists between cultivated fruit and the essence of the natural surroundings of this single vineyard in the Maipo Valley. The hillside vineyards were first planted in 1970. Jean-Pascal Lacaze is the distinguished winemaker and emphasizes low yields and non-interventionist farming of their grapes.

Domus Aurea Cabernet Sauvignon 2014

88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Petit Verdot, 4% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc
Considered one of the first cult, collectible wines from Chile, Domus Aurea immediately captured the attention of wine critics and has occupied a leading role in Chile’s recent wine history while gathering scores in the mid-nineties since its 1996 debut.

This vintage is a deep, intense dark ruby purple in the glass with aromas of cassis, blackberries, mineral and balsamic notes. It has herbs with subtle tones of spicy oak and in the mouth it is dense and concentrated but balanced. Will age beautifully for 20+ years.



Alba de Domus 2013 red wine

75% Cab Sauvignon, 12% Petit Verdot, 11% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc
It is called “the son” and it is the second wine to Domus Aurea, inheriting the same wine-making philosophy and terroir. Alba de Domus is deep ruby purple in the glass, it has aromas of candied cherry and raspberries. A swirl reveals wild berries and minty hints, balanced with an integrated structure of fine tannins and a ripe juicy texture. Lively and smooth, it has an elegant body that evolves into a bright finish.

Peñalolen Cabernet Sauvignon 2016

75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc, 8% Petit Verdot, 4% Merlot, 3% Carménère



The Peñalolen Cabernet Sauvignon vineyard produces excellent low-yield fruit and was established next to the Domus Aurea vineyard 35 years ago. Peñalolen truly is a family-owned, boutique property committed to making wines of uniqueness.

This is a complex and velvety wine with abundant fruit of wild berries and cassis, and a refined whisper of eucalyptus with tremendous length.

Anka 2013 organic red blend

60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 16% Cabernet Franc, 10% Merlot, 7% Carmenere, 5% Syrah, 2% Petit Verdot



Anka is a vibrant, **organic** red Bordeaux blend with a splash of Syrah. It is a deep ruby color in the glass with floral hints of sweet spice accompanied by a roundness in the mouth that is lush, but not heavy, and the texture is velvety with fine tannins.

Jean-Pascal Lacaze organically farms the grapes at his Maipo Valley vineyard, Parga. Using only hand-selected and picked fruit, he ages 20% of the wine in French oak barrels.



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
