## **MAQUIS** — Emerging as one of the great wineries of Chile!

The producer of “Lien”, a magnificent blend of Syrah, Carmenère, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Malbec, this terroir-driven wine is a fine pedigree full of ripe plum and blackberry fruit. Maquis recently added three new varieties, a Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere and Rosé.

## **APALTAGUA**

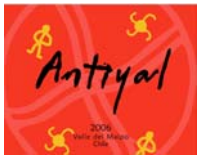
These old vineyards are located in the prestigious Apalta region of Colchagua, renowned for producing some of the best red wines in Chile. Made under the watchful eye of consulting winemaker Alvaro Espinoza.

- **Reserva Chardonnay** — Crisp and refreshing with citrus and a long finish; unoaked.
- **Carmenère Rosé**— Fresh aromas of strawberries, roses, spiced tannins and long finish.
- **Reserva Pinot Noir**— A terrific value in Pinot Noir with aroma of cherries and raspberries.
- **Reserva Carmenère**— A classic Bordeaux grape variety; chocolaty and food friendly.
- **Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon**— An exceptional value in Cabernet; lightly oaked.
- **Gran Reserva “Envero” Carmenère**— A dark, rich wine with undertones of black cherries and coffee.
- **Signature Cabernet Sauvignon** — An elegant and concentrated wine from Pirque.
- **Grial Carmenère**—One of the best Carmenères being produced today.

## ANTIYAL

Among the best wines being produced in South America— and a perennial *Wine Spectator* favorite. This organic and biodynamic blend comes from internationally celebrated winemaker Alvaro Espinoza.

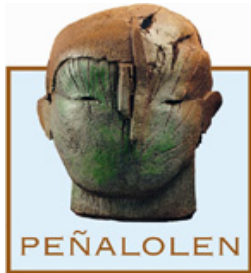


## KUYEN

A tiny production, biodynamic “baby Antiyal” red blend from Alvaro Espinoza. Great mineral quality with blueberry fruit.

## PARGUA & ANKA

Pargua is a new, limited-production organic wine blend from the maker of Domus Aurea. It’s fleshy, juicy, and balanced with a spicy finish. Anka is a moderately priced sequel to Pargua with integrated tannins and notes of wild berry, dried fruit and sweet spice. 100% organic fruit.



## PEÑALOLÉN

A family-owned, boutique winery that produces three Chilean wines of distinction: **Sauvignon Blanc** is pure and free of oak with brisk acidity; **Cabernet Franc** is full-bodied and intense with notes of berry and currant; **Cabernet Sauvignon** is complex and velvety and made from 100% estate fruit.

## MELI

The dream of celebrated winemaker Adriana Cerda, Meli winery uses dry farming and 60-year-old vines to produce two unique wines: **Dry Riesling** and **Carignan**— both unusual for Chile but well-suited to the cool vineyards of the western Maule Valley.

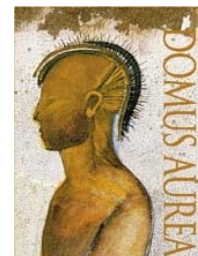


## WILLIAM COLE & ALBAMAR

Owned by Bill Cole and his family, this winery in the Casablanca Valley specializes in cool climate varieties, including **Sauvignon Blanc**, **Chardonnay** and **Pinot Noir**. They also produce a **Cabernet Sauvignon** from the Colchagua Valley.

## DOMUS AUREA

Hailing from one of the finest vineyards in the Maipo Valley, this age-worthy **Cabernet Sauvignon** is a *Wine Spectator* favorite year after year.



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## RICARDO SANTOS

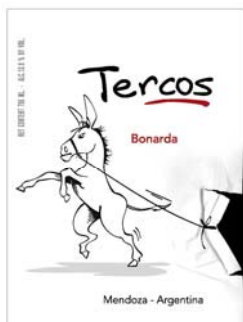
One of the top producers of Malbec in Argentina, Ricardo Santos, known as “Mr. Malbec,” was the first to export the varietal out of Argentina to the USA.



- **Malbec**— A complex core of ripe blackberry, finishing with elegant silkiness. Santos Malbec grapes are harvested and selected by hand, gently pressed, and only the first pressed juice used. The wine is then aged in French and American oak for six months.
- **Cabernet Sauvignon**— Introducing a Cabernet from vines that are grown in a tiny vineyard located in the Uco Valley. The area is known for its unique microclimates at the foot of the Andes mountain. The resulting wine is rich and complex, ideal for aging.
- **Dry Semillon**— Surprisingly complex and intriguing; attractive fig and wild fruit flavors. Finishes dry and long.

## TERCOS

Tercos winery is owned by brothers Pedro and Patricio Santos (the adult sons of pioneering Argentine winemaker Ricardo Santos).



- **Malbec**— Young, bright and refreshing; a great value.
- **Sangiovese** — Attractive aromatics of ripe strawberries and black cherry.
- **Bonarda**— Unoaked, vibrant and full of fresh red fruits.
- **Torrontes**— Dry and refreshing with flavors of grapefruit, peach, apple, melon and pineapple.

## MARICHAL

Bodega Marichal is located about 20 miles north of Uruguay's capitol, Montevideo in the small town, or department of Canalones. Its the proximity to the Atlantic ocean is especially ideal for cultivating the Tannat grape, Uruguay's prominent grape variety.
