Located in Chile's Maule Valley, Gillmore is a family-owned winery founded in 1990, but with vineyards over 60 years old. Daniella Gillmore and her husband Andrés Sanchez produce and bottle estate-grown wines from their own Loncomilla vineyards. The fruit is harvested by hand and the wine is produced using traditional dry farming techniques. Gillmore is a founding member of MOVI and VIGNO, which are guilds of family-owned wineries with a mission to preserve small winemaking operations in the Maule Valley.

GILLMORE MARIPOSA CARIGNAN 2019

Made with estate fruit and aged in French oak for 10 months, the Carignan has a deep red cherry color. On the nose it has very intense aromas of red fruit, with complex notes of earth, bay leaf and mint. Firm tannins and a juicy acidity give this wine a special personality. 100% old-vine, unirrigated and estate fruit.

GILLMORE MARIPOSA PAÍS 2019

Produced in small batches from old vines, the País has a natural acidity that lends well to aging. It has aromas of strawberries and raspberries and in the mouth it is dry, fresh, balanced and medium-bodied. País is a uniquely Chilean variety and is produced from estate fruit that is dry-farmed. 100% País.



GILLMORE MARIPOSA RED BLEND 2018 A blend of 50% Cabernet Franc, 25% Merlot and 25% Syrah, the fruit is dry-farmed from low-yield, 50 year-old organically farmed estate vines. Abundant aromas of red raspberries and strawberries follow an elegant dry acidity in the mouth. The wine is fresh, concentrated and well-balanced.
