

# CHILE'S FIRST ICON CABERNET FRANC

Maquis Franco represents the culmination of painstaking efforts made by three generations of the Hurtado family to create a truly exceptional wine. This majestic Cabernet Franc is outstanding for its elegance and length on the palate.

## Unique Terroir

Located in Colchagua Valley, the vineyard terroir shows the marked influence of its geographic position, totally surrounded by the Tinguiririca River and the Chimbarongo Creek. These two large waterways, which once brought alluvial sediments from The Andes, now act as pathways for cool coastal breezes that help moderate the warm Colchagua summers, contributing to the intensity and fruitiness of the wines.





## Maquis Franco 2008

Intense, velvety red color. This wine boasts aromas of great intensity and complexity, with fresh red fruit over a delicate floral background. The mouth is balanced, with an impressive volume and tannic structure. Its finish is subtle and persistent.



### Maquis Franco 2009

Dark cherry color. This wine conveys notes of plums, chocolate, blackberries, blueberries and violets in the nose. The mouth is broad and rich, with preeminent, firm and elegant tannins.



# Maquis Franco 2010

Dark cherry color. The nose highlights crisp red fruits, blackberries and blueberries, with a glimpse of lavender and a touch of licorice. The flavors are well structured, with excellent volume, elegant tannins and a fresh, persistent finish.
