The "Premium Varietal" line is produced with hand-picked fruit that reflects the purest expression of each variety. The wines are fresh, young and unoaked.

2013 Tannat is well-balanced, medium-bodied with a long finish.

Marichal Reserve Collection

Specially selected grapes with the potential to make a complex wine are hand-picked and bottled in very limited quantities. The wines are aged in used French oak barrels.


Marichal Grand Reserve Tannat

This is a limited release (2,000 bottles), ultra-premium wine. Complex, intense and full-bodied.

Bordering Brazil and Argentina, the country of Uruguay is home to many small wineries that were first planted by Basque and Italian immigrants as far back as the 1870s. The climate and soil are ideal components for bringing new life to old grape varieties such as Tannat.

Marichal is headed by winemakers Juan Andrés and Alejandro Marichal. They are a family-owned winery originally established in 1938 and they are now into their third and fourth generation of family winemaking. The vineyards are located at an ideal latitude in the department, or province, of Canelones (15 miles north of Uruguay's capitol, Montevideo) where the warm weather, cool Atlantic breezes and deep clay soil allow varieties like Tannat thrive and achieve unique character.

91 points: Marichal Tannat Grand Reserve "A" 2011 "This ultra-premium 100% Tannat is richly flavored with dried fruit and baking spice notes complementing fresh dark fruit, finishing firm and dry."

90 points: Marichal Pinot Noit/Tannat Rsv Collection 2011 "Very interesting blend that is surprisingly successful- aged in oak for 10 months. Pleasant red fruited bouquet and good richness."
