Calcu Rosé is a bright blend of 70% Malbec and 30% Cabernet Sauvignon. Malbec lends elegant floral aromas and the Cabernet Sauvignon gives body to the wine, but blended together they offer fresh fruit aromas while maintaining crisp acidity. In the glass the Rosé is a brilliant rich pink color with hints of wild berries. It will pair well with most foods, especially goat cheese, seafood, grilled chicken and delicate asian dishes.

Apaltagua Rosé is 85% Carmenere and 15% Syrah. The fruit is from the Huaquen Estate in Maule Valley. Apaltagua's farming practices help produce a unique Rosé that is light pink in color, fresh on the nose and crisp on the palate. This wine blooms with aromas of rose petal, smokey balsamic, and spice followed by a long and vibrant finish.
