ARGENTINA REPORT_____

Aniello Chardonnay 2019, 92 points

A dense style of chardonnay with dried-apple and light walnut character, as well as cedar. Full body. Solid, yet fresh at the finish.

Aniello Malbec 2019, 92 points

A rich, ripe wine that shows dried berries and hints of figs and spice. Medium body, medium-chewy tannins and a flavorful finish. Juicy blackberry finish that's really fresh and zesty.

Aniello Trousseau 2017, 92 points

Aromas of flowers, sliced oranges and vibrant berries, such as sliced raspberries. Medium-bodied with bright fruit and acidity. Light tannins. Vivid finish.

Funckenhausen Cabernet Sauvignon 2019, 90 points

Ripe plum, stewed blackcurrant, tobacco, licorice and gravel on the nose. It's medium-bodied with sleek tannins. Smooth and fleshy with a spiced finish.

Funckenhausen Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, 90 points

A rich, swarthy and ripe feel with boldly fleshy, plum-cake and plum-compote flavors, delivered in supple, juicy mode.

Ricardo Santos Sémillon 2020, 90 points

Waxed lemon, apricot stone, blanched almond and cardmom on the nose. It's medium-bodied, with bright acidity. Concentrated and waxy with intense, almond-paste character.

Ricardo Santos Sémillon 2019, 90 points

Lemon rind with some pineapple aromas follow through to a medium-to full-bodied palate and a fruity finish. A little waxy at the end.

Tercos Malbec 2020, 90 points

Plum, blackberry and sweet-tobacco aromas. Medium-bodied with sleek tannins and a fresh, lightly stemmy and juicy finish.

Tercos Malbec 2018, 91 points

An easy, fruity malbec with plum and light chocolate character, as well as hazelnuts. Medium body, fine tannins and a delicious finish.

Tercos Torrontés 2019, 90 points

Green-melon and sliced-citrus aromas here that follow through to a medium-bodied, lightly off-dry palate and a medium finish.

CHILE REPORT

Calcu Cabernet Franc Gran Reserva 2018, 90 points Good density and weight, firmish tannins and layers of black fig.

Calcu Cabernet Sauvignon Gran Reserva 2018, 90 points Racy acidity, well-integrated oak and appealing freshness.

Calcu Futa 2017, 93 points

Bold, textured, focused and intense, it's a Bordeaux-meets-Colchagua style, with plenty of structure, minerality and acidity.

Calcu Winemaker's Selection 2018, 93 points

Typical of the fresh, acid-drive wines made by Ricardo Rivadeneira and Rodrigo Romero. Perfumed, intense and spicy.

Gillmore Hacedor de Mundos Cabernet Franc 2018, 95 points

Rich, textured and plush, with wonderful underlying freshness.

Gillmore Mariposa Red Blend 2018, 92 points

Harmonious, attractive and elegant. Stylishly proportioned, as the Gillmore reds tend to be.

Gillmore País del Maule 2019, 91 points

A bright, crunchy, stainless steel-fermented País with rose petal aromas, juicy summer pudding fruit flavours.

Gillmore Wines VIGNO 2018, 95 points

Herbal, floral and nuanced, this is a pure carignan.

Maquis Cabernet Franc Gran Reserva 2018, 92 points Floral and leafy, fresh acidity, stylish oak.

Maquis Cabernet Sauvignon Gran Reserva 2018, 93 points Blackcurrant and blueberry fruit, subtle oak influence.

Maguis Carménère Gran Reserva 2018, 92 points

Good depth and intensity, mocha oak notes, fresh acidity and flavours of bramble, black cherry.

Maquis Rosé Gran Reserva 2020, 92 points

Serious style and more structure than most pink wines.

Maquis Franco 2017, 96 points

Focused, stony, floral and nuanced.

Maquis Lien 2017, 95 points

Fresh, floral and subtle, with bramble and blackcurrant leaf flavor.

Maquis Viola 2017, 95 points

Showing the polish and refinement that are hallmarks of the Maquis style. Defined, textured and graceful.
