Anka comes from the Domus Aurea family of wines of the Maipo Valley. Chief winemaker, Jean-Pascal Lacaze, brings his training and experience from Bordeaux to produce award-winning wines. He uses only the finest organic fruit for Anka from his personal vineyard located on the gravelly slopes of Alto Maipo at the foot of the Andes Mountains in Chile.

“Alto” Maipo Valley

The Maipo Valley wine making region is divided into three territories (from the coast of Chile to the Andes mountains): Pacific, Central and Alto with Anka vineyards in the Alto Maipo. The harsh high elevation climate and warm daily temperatures are key to a low-yield harvest, high-quality fruit. Each harvest occurs on a plot-by-plot and basis, the winery utilizes open-top fermentation and individualized oak-aging cycles for specifically selected vineyard plots. The selections are barrel-aged then the wines are blended manually.

Organic Red Blend

Anka is a vibrant, organic red blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Carmenere, Syrah and Petit Verdot. It is deep garnet in the glass with berries, spice and dried herb on the nose. A closer examination reveals cigar, oak, black currants, dried flowers and cherry liquor. The wine is smooth and wide with a harmonious balance in the mouth. Rich and lush, but not heavy, it has a velvety texture and well integrated tannins. Anka is available in 750ml and a new 375ml size.
