LAPOSTOLLE

Borobo Chile 2010

93 points | \$78 | 500 cases imported | Red

A polished red, with a deep vein of dark currant, plum, chocolate and mocha flavors, well-structured and supported by muscular tannins. The finish is filled with wild cherry and spice notes, presenting hints of black olive. Drink now through 2019.-K.M.

VIÑA ERRÁZURIZ

Don Maximiano Founder's Reserve Aconcagua Valley 2011 92 points | \$90 | 500 cases imported | Red

Shows good cut to the dark fig, dried blackberry and plum flavors, accented by plenty of smoky notes. Dense midpalate, with brooding hints of dried meat and paprika. This is long and savory on the finish, well-balanced and filled with black licorice accents. Drink now through 2018.-K.M.

VIÑEDOS LAGAR DE BEZANA

Aluvion Gran Reserva Alto Cachapoal 2011 92 points | \$29 | 280 cases imported | Red

A suave, extracted style, with plenty of hot stone notes to the firmly tannic flavors of dried raspberry, plum, mineral and spice. Toasty accents mix with hints of green olive and white pepper, extending on the firm finish. Drink now through 2018.-K.M.

VIÑA PEÑALOLÉN

Cabernet Sauvignon Maipo Valley 2011 91 points | \$19 | 4,500 cases made | Red

Features a core of powerful currant, cherry and raspberry flavors, with subtle minty notes. Offers sinewy tannins midpalate, balanced by a mix of dried meat, olive and wild herb. Pepper and spice accents define the elegant finish. Drink now through 2018.-K.M.

VINA KOYLE

Cabernet Sauvignon Colchagua Valley Alto Gran Reserva 2011 90 points | \$17 | 11,100 cases made | Red

Offers mineral-infused red fruit and savory spice flavors that are structured and well-focused, accented by plenty of green olive notes. A latent creaminess extends onto the lively finish. Drink now through 2017.-K.M.

LAPOSTOLLE

Canto de Apalta Rapel Valley 2011 90 points | \$21 | 15,200 cases made | Red

A powerful and muscular red, with concentrated dark plum, dried blackberry and dark currant flavors that support plenty of baker's chocolate and black fig notes. Finishes firmly tannic, showing hints of mocha and paprika. Drink now through 2018.-K.M.
