

Owned and produced by the William Cole family, Albamar wines come from the prestigious Casablanca Valley, often called "Chile's Burgundy." The name Albamar pays homage to the valley's foggy sunrise (alba means sunrise) and the cooling breezes of the ocean (mar means ocean). The unique coastal location of the vineyard provides a long, warm growing season with cool nights, resulting in wines with refreshing acidity. The grapes are 100% estate grown and picked by hand. Albamar wines are an excellent value.
