“**Bargain of the Week**”

Dan Berger calls this wine “a delightful surprise in a dry Riesling from Chile. Apple, pear, citrus, and pine aromas with a relatively dry finish. From 60-year-old vines.”



2008 Meli Carignane

“**Wine of the Week**”

“Dark fruits leaning on plum, pepper, and a bit of sage, all wrapped in a tart, crisp red wine that exhibits the workhorse nature of this often-overlooked grape variety. This wine, from old carignane vines, has only 13% alcohol and real food friendliness.”
