

Gillmore Mariposa Field Blend 2020

Our Philosophy

Located in Chile's Maule Valley, Gillmore is a family-owned winery founded in 1990, but with vineyards over 60 years old. Daniella Gillmore and her husband Andrés Sanchez produce and bottle estate-grown wines from their own Loncomilla vineyards. The fruit is harvested by hand and the wine is produced using traditional dry farming techniques. The terroir is expressed in mature wines, concentrated and elegant with a natural acidity that achieves the perfect balance to withstand a long evolution in bottle.

Mariposa represents spring, joy and happiness, and is a wine to share and enjoy.

Vineyard

The Tabontinaja Vineyards benefit from singular soil composition. Terraces made up of alluvial clay soils and deep colluvial rocks accommodate deep root systems without excessive fertility. The gently rolling hills ensure good drainage. This combination results in a low yield of distinctive fruit.

Fermentation

It was fermented in steel tanks using traditional techniques, pumped over three times a day and stored in barrels.

Tasting Notes

Complex red wine flavors, raspberries and strawberries highlighted. The palate has an interesting structure with lively acidity. This wine is dry and freshness comes from the fruit.
